## *Welcome to Saint Cecilia Cathedral*

***Welcome Home! A Procession of Organists Past***, the first in a series of twelve monthly concerts during the Inaugural Year of the Saint Cecilia Organ by Martin Pasi, honors the many organists who have served Saint Cecilia over the years. All of these organists stand in the shadow of Winifred Traynor Flanagan, who served for 50 years from 1921-1971. Together they represent an unbroken musical tradition of music making spanning 85 years since the first cathedral organ was installed. It is fitting that the first *Third Sunday at Three* recital should pay tribute to the heritage begun with the gift of organ in 1918 by the descendents of Vincent and Theresa Berkley, who founded the first Catholic church choir in Nebraska.

***The Third Sunday at Three Series*** depends entirely on free-will donations from patrons like you. You are invited to consider a donation of \$8 for today's concert to help us defray our expenses.
